This follows *Time Magazine's* 2017 report, in which Memphis is fourth on the list of the top 25 cities where millennials are moving. This trend is only expected to continue in coming years. Our welcoming culture cultivates young professional talent through structured programs like New Memphis Institute and Leadership Memphis, and while other cities become more generic, Memphis protects and builds on its authenticity, giving millennials ready plug-and-play opportunities.

In the last few years, Memphis has seen a huge surge in Memphians taking ownership of the path toward prosperity in their own neighborhoods. Where some cities are experiencing a lot of new development, Memphians are rethinking existing spaces, making Memphis a national leader for adaptive reuse of space. Over \$544.5 million has been invested in major revitalization projects in the Memphis area between 2014-2017, spanning from downtown Memphis to Shelby Farms Park. An abandoned Sears building was reimagined into a vertical urban village of art, retail, and education; \$3.8 billion in construction projects has spurred a renaissance across downtown

Memphis that's achieved over 90 percent occupancy for the first time in decades; a \$70 million capital improvement investment has made Shelby Farms Park one of the most desirable and pristine urban outdoor parks in the country. The 6.5 square mile Downtown Memphis has \$3.9 billion in planned and realized construction projects, including the \$751.5 million development Walk on Union , \$40 million in bike/pedestrian improvements, and a \$604 million investment in developing the Pinch District

Above entrepreneurs and education or development and lifestyle, Memphis is and has always been known for its unfailing generosity. Home to the headquarters of powerful philanthropic organizations like St. Jude Children's Research Hospital, which cures children from cancer all over the world, it's easy to see why Memphis was named the most generous city in America by the Chronicle of Philanthropy.
